

Consul General Lewis Lukens

Since August 2005, Mr. Lukens has served as US Consul General in Vancouver, the senior US government representative in British Columbia and the Yukon Territory. He reports directly to the US Ambassador in Ottawa, and supervises 62 employees from seven US government agencies in Vancouver.

Mr. Lukens has served with the US diplomatic corps since 1989. His prior postings include jobs in southern China, the Ivory Coast, Australia, Ireland, and Iraq, as well as in the State Department and the White House in Washington, DC.

Mr. Lukens has a BA in History and a Masters in Public Policy, both from Princeton University. He is joined in Vancouver by his wife, two daughters, and English springer spaniel.
